The purpose of the Lancer Baseball Camps is to provide fundamental baseball instruction for area youth and to help advance area baseball programs. The camps are designed to enhance their skills and to provide a unique opportunity for area youth to receive collegiate-level instruction from college baseball coaches.

ABOUT LANCER BASEBALL

The Mount Marty Lancer Baseball team has a proud tradition of putting competitive teams on the field and training quality student-athletes off the field.

On the field, the Lancers compete in the Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC) which is considered one of the top NAIA conferences in the country.

The GPAC has proven to be an exciting oppurtunity for the Lancers. In 2010 the Lancers were crowned GPAC Regular Season Champions. The 2010 season was a banner year for the Lancers setting school records for wins with 39 and a postseason run which finished up one game away from the NAIA World Series. In 2012 the Lancers had a strong finish to thier season capping it off with a GPAC Tournament Championship. In total, Mount Marty has won seven championships at the conference level over the last eighteen years.

Academically, the Lancers have also set a strong tradition in the classroom. The Lancers hold the record for recording the most Daktronics Scholar Athletes in a season with 10 for the 2006-07 school year. The Lancers have also been named an NAIA Baseball Scholar team the last ten seasons in which they have led the nation in four of those years for team GPA.

FALL HITTING CAMP

The Fall Hitting Camp is devised to cover offensive topics. Offensive drills will be provided to match each topic that has been covered. This camp segment is great to develop and polish your offensive skills during the off-season.

WINTER PITCHING CAMPS

The Pitching Camp will deliver advanced instruction to provide pitchers the opportunity to reach their maximum potential. Instruction topics include:

- Arm care
- Injury prevention
- Proper warm-up
- Pitching-specific training
- Mechanic drills
- Progressive throwing routine
- Mental mindset
- Developing off-speed pitches

PRESEASON HITTING LEAGUE

The Preseason Hitting League is set up to allow players to work on their swing before the season starts. Players will be able to develop offensive skills through a hitting station format each week. Each station will provide different drills to prepare the players for the upcoming season.

The camps will also give participants a chance to ask questions and get demonstrations from some of the area's premier baseball coaches. It also offers younger players some direction if they are interested in playing baseball after high school.
